

Unit 5: ABCs



Learning the sequence of the alphabet is easy when children view the "Alphabet Race". Watch the letters as they race over hills, some not making it across the water. Who will come last?

This unit covers all the letters of the alphabet, both lower and upper case and initial letter sounds. Each of the learning objects provides a variety of fun ways for children to learn the letters of the alphabet and gain an understanding of how the letters of the English language look and sound.

Objectives

- To identify and name the letters of the alphabet.
- To identify and name the sequence of the alphabet.
- To identify and say the short sound of each letter.
- To enable development of computer skills such as mouse control, drag and drop, selecting icons, navigating between objects and using drawing tools.
- To develop and extend written and spoken vocabulary of words associated with initial sounds and letters.
