Many have different degrees of difficulty to challenge children and to increase their computer skills.

Objectives

- To identify and name the numbers from one to twenty.
- To identify number words from one to ten.
- To count from one to twenty in numerical order.
- To identify properties of numbers from one to twenty.
- To develop computer skills such as mouse control, drag and drop, selecting icons, navigating between objects and using drawing tools.
- To develop and extend written and spoken vocabulary of words associated with numbers.
